



Crusader fans! Welcome to another season of Brother Rice High School football! We are thrilled to be back home at Gary Little Stadium in Week 5 of the 2023 season. After careful consideration and many administrative meetings with local law enforcement and security, we have decided to implement new policies and procedures to ensure the safety of our fans and community. Below are some highlights that we ask you to be prepared to comply with for Brother Rice home athletic events for the 2023-24 school year.

**Arrival and Parking:** Parking on and around the campus is limited, so please arrive early.

On game nights, vehicles should enter the main parking lot at the northernmost Pulaski entrance just south of 99th St. Please do not double-park or park in the bus and fire lanes, or your vehicle may be towed. The lot fills quickly, but additional parking is available at the front entrance lot, farther south off of Pulaski. For some games, the Mother McAuley High School lot may be available for auxiliary parking on the east side of the stadium. If all lots are full, additional parking is available on the residential streets north of 99th St.; please respect our neighbors and their property.

**Ticket Prices:**

Adults: \$7

High School Students w/ ID: \$5

Seniors (65+): \$2

K-8 Students: Free

We will also accept cash or credit cards at the gate until the start of the second half. There will be a \$1 service fee for all GoFan/credit card purchases.

All high school students with a valid high school ID will be admitted with the purchase of a student ticket. Brother Rice and Mother McAuley students will be free with school ID. Students must present a school ID at the gate to be admitted into the stadium.

All grammar school students need to be accompanied by an adult upon entry. Grammar school students wearing Brother Rice or their own grammar school jerseys or spiritwear will be admitted to regular season home football games free.

### Security:

There will be no re-entry into Gary Little Stadium. Gates to the facility will close at the start of the second half.

### Approved Bags:

- Clear bags (no larger than 12" x 12" x 6")
- 1-gallon resealable plastic storage bag
- Small clutch purse (no larger than 4.5" x 6.5") and fanny packs.

No backpacks will be allowed past the entry gate or in the stadium.

At the conclusion of the contest, we ask that you please make your way to the exit in a timely and orderly manner. Please do not loiter in bleachers and/or our parking lots and be courteous to other guests while leaving the stadium and campus.
